Report on the Financial Statements

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of Sundram Fasteners Investments Limited ("the company"), which comprise the Balance Sheet as at 31st March 2018, the Statement of Profit and Loss, the Cash Flow Statement for the year then ended, and a summary of the significant accounting policies and other explanatory information .

Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements
